PIANO BAR SINGING ENTERTAINER-DOWNTOWN Application

A singer engaged by a club, restaurant, or room, performing as an obligation of employment as part of the entertainment package in such establishment without fixed set lists or specific show times. Eligible singers must have other responsibilities, such as waiting tables or bartending. There is a 40-performance minimum requirement, which refers to the number of evenings/afternoons the candidate performed on his or her regularly scheduled shift(s) or subbing in 2024. A candidate who worked in both uptown and downtown venues in 2024 should submit in the category that matches the location of the majority of his/her eligible performances. If the candidate is not a MAC member, the venue must be a MAC member club in the greater New York metropolitan area for an engagement to be eligible.
